Essay Topic

Alpha Phi Alpha: Marching Forward By Looking Back

The date was August 28, 1963, the venue was the Lincoln Memorial, and the event was the march on Washington for Jobs and Freedom. The final speaker for the day was the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., a visionary advocate for civil and social change and a prominent member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc. It was here on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial that he would deliver his historical speech, "I Have A Dream", challenging Americans to honor the principles upon which this nation was founded. In August 2013, citizens from all parts of our country converged on the nation's capital to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the March on Washington and Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s Historical speech.

AS a part of this historical celebration, high school students were asked to share their views on the education and violence, and what is necessary to improve their lives as students and citizens. We are asking you to share your view by typing a 500-word essay that addresses; **What would be two things that you would do today to improve the lives of your fellow students and citizens in your community and why?**

The essay must be typed and double-spaced. The Times New Roman (14pt) is the desired font.
